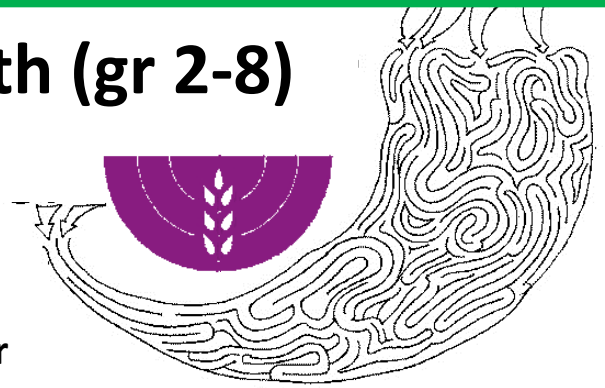


GJC's High Holidays for Youth (gr 2-8)

Youth Services

11 AM: Rosh ha-Shanah Day 1 & Yom Kippur

Rosh ha-Shanah in the Woods: A Family Hike for K-8th Grade

Join Rabbi Alanna, Dove, and Rabbi Shai for a hands-on High Holiday experience with stories, mindfulness, exploration, prayer, and activities. *K-5th graders must be with an adult (family or trusted family friend) or older sibling; adults are asked that they do not supervise more than 4 children. 6th-8th graders may attend on their own.*

Kol Nidrei Kids' Service | 2nd-6th grade service in Room 307

Youth Programming (pre-registration required, form on back)

Kids' Lunch (pre-registration required) | \$5/lunch

Children 6 & under should attend lunch with an adult. Registration is required for lunch for kids of all ages!

Camp Yom-Tov (gr 2-6) | \$5/each, per child

Camp Yom Tov, staffed by teen *madrechim* (counselors), provides fun, supervised activities and play for your child before youth services begin on Rosh ha-Shanah Days 1 and 2 and on Yom Kippur morning and afternoon.

Rosh ha-Shanah-Rama & Explore Yom Kippur (gr 2-6) | \$5/each, per child

These supervised, holiday-themed programs are full of great activities for youth in grades 2 through 6. Programs will run after kids' lunch through the end of morning portion of services on Rosh ha-Shanah Day 1 and Yom Kippur.

Kol Nidrei Youth Program (gr 2-6) | \$10/child

Directly following the Kol Nidrei Youth Service, children pre-registered for this program will stay on for an hour of supervised programming before joining with their adults for the final hour of Kol Nidrei services.

Kids' Ne'ila (Yom Kippur evening) \$10/child

Pre-register for a program filled with stories, mindfulness, and singing at the end of Yom Kippur. We will conclude by joining the larger community in the Charry Sanctuary for the sounding of the shofar.

PLEASE NOTE: All children below 7th grade must be supervised at all times, either by an adult family member or in one of our high holiday programs/services. Children of all ages are welcome to participate fully in all of our High Holiday services and programs in the Charry Sanctuary and our minyanim!
