

GJC's High Holiday Childcare (6 months-1st grade)

Registration forms, immunization records, and payment are necessary by Thursday, September 26th.

Germantown Jewish Centre's High Holiday childcare sessions are supervised by teachers from GJC's Early Childhood Program, with teens assisting in the classrooms. Each session includes time on the playground (weather permitting), stories, and supervised play.

It is the policy of GJC that all children must be fully immunized in order to participate in childcare at GJC. **Please note the following important information:**

- ALL children must be pre-registered and GJC must have a current copy of their immunization record to attend High Holiday childcare. No walk-ins will be admitted on the day of.
- You must submit the child's immunization record at the time of registering for High Holiday childcare. Your
 registration is not complete without an immunization record, and your child will not be admitted without a
 complete registration.
- If your child is enrolled in ECP or Religious School with a current copy of their immunization record, you do NOT have to resubmit the records when you register for High Holiday childcare.

Childcare is for ages 6 months to 1st grade. There are several pricing options available this year.

Family Plan (pricing includes any and all sessions): \$85 (1 child) | \$120 (2+ children)

Individual Sessions (pricing is for one session only):

Rosh ha-Shanah Day 1, 2 & Yom Kippur: \$30 each (1 child) | \$45 each (2+ children) Kol Nidrei & N'ilah: \$20 each (1 child) | \$30 each (2+ children)

If you register your children age 6 & under for lunch, please escort them yourselves to lunch and return them to childcare afterwards or deliver the lunch to your child's room. Thank you!
