It is the policy of GJC that all children must be fully immunized in order to participate in childcare at GJC. Please note the following information in regards to using High Holiday childcare at Germantown Jewish Centre:

- ALL children must be pre-registered and GJC must have a current copy of their immunization record to attend High Holiday childcare. No walk-ins will be admitted on the day of.
- You must submit the child's immunization record at the time of registering for High Holiday childcare. Your
 registration is not complete without an immunization record, and your child will not be admitted without a
 complete registration.
- If your child is enrolled in ECP or Religious School with a current copy of their immunization record, you do NOT have to resubmit the records when you register for High Holiday childcare.
