Youth Programming (pre-registration required - see separate form)

It is the policy of GJC that all children must be fully immunized in order to participate in youth programming at GJC. **Please note the following important information:**

- ALL children must be pre-registered and GJC must have a current copy of their immunization record to attend High Holiday youth programs. No walk-ins will be admitted on the day of.
- You must submit the child's immunization records at the time of registering for High Holiday youth programs. Your registration is not complete without an immunization record, and your child will not be admitted without a complete registration.
- If your child is enrolled in Religious School with a current copy of their immunization record, you do NOT have to resubmit the records when you register for High Holiday youth programs.



Camp Yom Tov (gr 2-6) | \$5/each session, per child

\$5 per child/per session | 9:30-11 AM & 1:00-2:00 PM | Rosh ha-Shanah & Yom Kippur

\$10 per child | 7:00-8:00 PM | Kol Nidrei

\$10 per child | 5:15-7:15 PM | Yom Kippur at N'ilah

Camp Yom Tov, staffed by teen *madrechim* (counselors), provides fun, supervised activities and play for your child on Rosh ha-Shanah Days 1 & 2 in the mornings and on Yom Kippur morning and afternoon. On Kol Nidrei, directly following the youth service, registered children will stay on for an hour of supervised programming before joining with their adults for the final hour of Kol Nidrei services. For N'ilah, Camp Yom Tov is filled with stories, mindfulness, and singing at the end of Yom Kippur. We will conclude by joining the larger community in the Charry Sanctuary for the sounding of the shofar.



Kids' Lunch (pre-registration required) | \$5/lunch

Children 6 & under should attend lunch with an adult. Registration is required for lunch for kids of all ages!

**Registration forms, immunization records, and payment
are necessary by Thursday, September 26th.**

PLEASE NOTE: All children below 7th grade must be supervised at all times, either by an adult family member or in one of our children's programs/services. Children of all ages are welcome to participate fully in all of our High Holiday services and programs in the Charry Sanctuary and our minyanim!
